QUALIFICATIONS: Full-time graduate students in Economics who are candidates for the doctoral or master's degree. Preference is given to doctoral students for the graduate-level courses.

NATURE OF DUTIES: Leading discussion groups and/or problem sessions, invigilation of exams, grading assignments and exams, holding office hours.

ESTIMATED HOURS OF WORK: 384 hours during the Winter Session per full position.
384 hours during the Summer Session per full position.

SALARY: \$11,570.00 for a Graduate Teaching Assistant I.
A GTA-I is defined as a graduate student who holds a masters degree and/or is registered in a doctoral degree program at the University of British Columbia or who is a student who holds a master's or doctoral degree in the posted discipline.

\$11,133.36 for a Graduate Teaching Assistant II.
A GTA-II is defined as a graduate student who holds a bachelors degree and/or is registered at the University of British Columbia in a master's degree program or who is a student who holds a bachelor's degree in the posted discipline. An employee who is registered in a diploma or licentiate programme shall be appointed as a GTA-II.
